

Low-Income Monthly Transit Pass

Am I Eligible?

If you:

- have been a resident of Calgary for 1 year
- are 18 years of age or older
- have photo identification
- had a 2005 yearly income below \$15,500 as stated on your income tax return (Notice of Assessment)

You may be eligible for a Calgary Transit Low-Income Monthly Transit pass for \$37.50.

- 2005 Federal Tax Notice of Assessment (no other documents accepted) or AISH Health Benefits card with "X" classification
